The first floor features a new bar area with a fully-equipped kitchen, designed to offer fresh, high-quality cuisine.


The renovation of the second-floor gallery not only fosters a sense of community but also supports local street artists by providing a platform for their work, accompanied by a comfortable resting area for visitors.



PROJECT DISCRIPTION

The NUNU venue in Italy underwent a transformation inspired by the charm and characteristics of Jason Momoa's Aquaman persona.

The design aimed to capture Aquaman's ethos without making the restaurant overtly themed, achieving an elegant yet fun atmosphere.

Bar materials were carefully chosen to match Aquaman's color scheme, incorporating dark blue ceramic tiles and green leather cushion seats with gold accents to evoke the undersea kingdom of Atlantis.

The challenge was to integrate Atlantis features without being overly themed, resulting in a sophisticated gold bar resembling an underworld kingdom.

The floor plan, inspired by the Atlantis map, created distinct sections like 'King's Armory' and 'Council of Worship,' with a music section for live performances, a lounge area with regal ambience, and a central I-shaped table for large events, culminating in a captivating and sophisticated space that embraces the spirit of a fabled underwater kingdom.



Using elements like exposed brick and warm wood, personalized lockers secure mementos, fostering emotional connections and encouraging return visits.


The transformation into an entertainment space includes an industrial love lock area, billiard board, and game zone for customer satisfaction.

Thoughtful smoking zones, with industrial aesthetics, ensure comfort.


The advanced ventilation system enhances the overall Seoul-inspired experience, creating a memorable venue that goes beyond a traditional drinking spot.
